Subject: Public Call Number Indexes Show Staff Only Titles
Proposal: BL2450.P9H7 lists in the Main call no. index. A patron noticed and reported to Beverly Sperring. David Larsen forwarded to me. mq_index callc is a "combined" index, it includes staff only. We cannot make a separate index excluding staff_only. We have several call no. indexes where this should be done.

Subject: Batch Spine Labels - Need to Use Spine Breaker

Proposal: Use spine breaker to put line breaks in batch exported spine labels when they are actually sent to be batch printed via the ``Export All`` command. When we pull up the items to be printed in the ``edit the items to be printed`` window, call numbers appear correctly broken across lines. HOWEVER, when we ``Export All`` and then open up the exported labels in Word and look at them, the call numbers are not formatted with the spine breaker as they should be, we just see a row of as much of call no. as it can squeeze on one line, then a word wrap. It is costing much staff time to manually enter all line breaks for each spint label after it is batch exported to our template.

Subject: Diacritic in MARC Editor

Proposal: Combining (non-spacing) diacritics doesn't display correctly in Marc Editor sometimes. For example, type a letter `e` with cedilla (short cut is F7, c), it is displayed as `[F0 65]`. However, letter `a` with cedilla displays correctly in Marc Editor. For detail, see log 1473177.

Subject: Allow for Printer-friendly Printing from Cataloging

Proposal: The Horizon cataloging editor allows for customization, including setting colors for background and record elements. Many of our catalogers have chosen dark background colors to reduce eye strain. In previous versions, printouts of the cataloging screen ignored the background colors. Version 7.3.3 does not. As a result, we have had to set our background color to white or light grey. Even so, we will be using more toner than before. Please provide a printer-friendly way to print from cataloging, one that ignores background colors. Please give us something more than just a screen print.

Subject: Web Reporter

Proposal: Web Reporter is lacking key columns in the copy record and tables related to serials. These fields include the collection and the retention note. A field such as the collection is critical to identifying the physical location of material and should be added to the web reporter field selection along with addition columns.

Web reporter has hardcoded values that should be removed. For example, the report adds a `,1` to the `Start Enum` to represent the number e.g. `From 47,1` and a `12` to the `End Enum`. This can be misleading as we do not start all issues at number 1 (and not every journal uses number). Additional formatting capability is needed.

Limitations for ASP customers for Web Reporter related tools should be resolved.
