**Proposal:** We would like the ability to bar itypes from checking out using SIP but not from checking in. We currently have the selfcheck\_barred\_itype table in Horizon set up to bar reference materials from checking out, because we do not want patrons to self-check them out. However, we do occasionally circulate reference materials (to other branches, for instance), so you can check them out using the Horizon client. We want our automated sorting system to be able to check in and handle those items when they get returned, not get rejected and have to be manually processed. Conceptually, there should just be a radio button for every row in selfcheck\_barred\_itype for ``checkout [ ] checkin [ ] both [ ]``
